Our workshops are for all. There is a strong focus on encouraging collaboration and the participation of all students. An ability to sing or play an instrument is not a pre-requisite.

What

A Songschool workshop offers a first hand insight into life as a professional songwriter / musician & an overview of song writing and the music business.

Students write and record their own songs during the workshop.

Each student receives a CD of their song (s), along with a Songschool / IMRO certificate of participation.

The workshop is supported by our web site www.songschool.ie where students can continue to access information to develop their skills. The site includes resource material, message board, forum, information & news sections.

Workshops are delivered by trained tutors who are (Irish Music Rights Organisation) IMRO Members. They make their living as a full or part time musician and or songwriter.

Tutors work closely with students in small groups

Where

Workshops are delivered on site at your school, youth centre, work or by arrangement they can take place at Troy Horse Music Centre in Balbriggan. We cover Ireland North, South, East or West.

Tutors bring all the necessary studio equipment (including drums). All tutors play at least one instrument.

Our website offers pre and post workshop support information so that students can continue to access information after their workshop has finished and they can continue to develop their skills. The site includes resource material, message board, forum, information & news sections.

Who

Songschool workshops are for all. There is a strong emphasis and focus on encouraging collaboration and the participation of all students.

An ability to sing or play an instrument is not a pre-requisite.

How

The duration and content of a workshop is flexible and can be adapted to suit the needs of particular schools and participants.

Recording workshops commonly last two full days or can be spread across several weeks.

Workshops can be designed to fit into existing teaching plans as part of a larger module or as a stand alone event.

Why

Gives students a chance to explore hidden talents and to express themselves

Builds self confidence

Develops interpersonal skills - Tutors work closely with students in small groups

It sets a challenge and provides a reward

Students learn to express themselves through words and music
