What?

A Songschool workshop offers a first hand insight into life as a professional songwriter / musician and an overview of song writing and the music business. Students write, perform and / or record their own songs during the workshop. Each student receives a CD of their song(s), along with a Songschool / IMRO certificate of participation.

The workshop is supported by our website www.songschool.ie, where students can continue to access information to develop their skills. The site includes resource material, message board, forum, information and news sections. Workshops are delivered by professional Songschool tutors.

Where?

Workshops are delivered on site at your school, youth centre, work or by arrangement they can take place at Troy Horse Music Centre in Balbriggan. Songschool delivers workshops and projects nationwide. Tutors bring all the necessary studio equipment (including drums).

When?

Workshops can be designed to fit into existing teaching plans as part of a larger module or as a stand alone project. Recording workshops commonly last two full days or can be spread across several weeks.

Who?

Workshops are flexible and adaptable to all age groups. Songschool workshops are non-exclusive. There is a strong emphasis and focus on encouraging collaboration and the participation of all students. An ability to sing or play an instrument is not a pre-requisite. Workshops can be tailored to suit specific needs. For example, there are specific workshops designed for Transition Year, Leaving Certificate and Junior Certificate students.

Why?

Gives students a chance to explore hidden talents and to express themselves. Builds confidence and self awareness. Develops interpersonal skills - tutors work closely with students in small groups. It sets a challenge and provides a reward. Students learn to express themselves through words and music.
